ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- ii. Participating in the delivery of face-to-face and online enquiry services;
- iii. Supporting and contributing to the development of relevant modules of the Library Management System;
- iv. Participating in management of the premises, ensuring safe, clean and well-maintained environments, equipment and facilities;
- v. Evaluating the information resources available and identifying areas of improvement to provide relevant resources to library users;
- vi. Contributing to overall library collection management and development;
- vii. Ensuring the application of the University College library policies, procedures and guidelines;
- viii. Participating in the delivery of student induction programmes;
- ix. Liaising with the academic programme departments through receiving the book request orders;
- x. Management of digital library collections and electronic resources including an institutional repository;
- xi. Administer library applications in the University server;
- xii. Training staff and students on the use of library systems and software's;
- xiii. Maintaining the Library website and database;
- xiv. Assist students and staff to effectively use the Library's catalogue.

QUALIFICATIONS

- i. Bachelor's Degree in Library/Information Science or equivalent from an accredited and recognized university;
- ii. At least six (6) years' relevant work experience;
- iii. Proficiency in computer applications;
- iv. Shown merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results;
- v. Membership in good standing to a relevant Professional body will be an added advantage;

vi. Fulfil the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Constitution.
